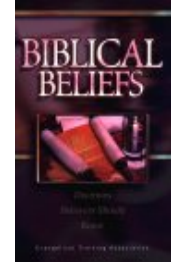

**Biblical Beliefs: Elder June Dow**

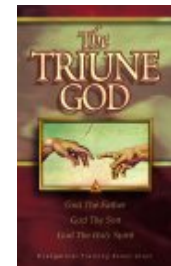

*Biblical Beliefs* interweaves deep Bible truths with structural threads all believers, whatever their spiritual experience, can fully grasp.

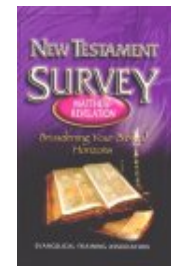
**The Triune God: Elder Clarence Dow**

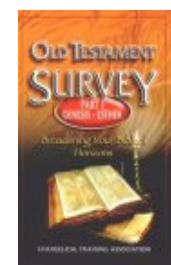
**New Testament Survey: Minister Karen Dickens**

*New Testament Survey* brings unity and chronological sequence to New Testament study by weaving the contents of the books around a central theme—the person of Christ. Divisions are the synoptic Gospels, the Gospel of John, the Book of Acts, the Pauline Epistles in chronological order, the General Epistles, and the Book of Revelation.



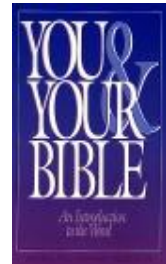
**Old Testament Survey Parts 1: Brother Larry Hollingsworth/Brother Bruce Sharp**

*Old Testament Survey 1* explores the exciting times of ancient Israel. It includes topics such as the patriarchs, Israel's trek to the Promised Land, David's reign, Solomon's kingdom, the kingdom of Judah, the exile, and the return from captivity.



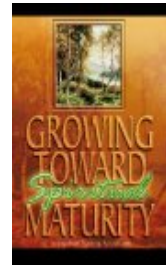
## **You and Your Bible: Minister Renee McCoy**

*You and Your Bible* holds that believers should be well informed about the Word of God. This course presents the inspiration and authorship of the Bible, how it was preserved, why we believe it, how we deal with its problems and critics, the role of archaeology, and ways to study the Bible more effectively. How did we get the Bible? Who wrote the Scriptures? How can we answer the Bible critics? Why do we believe the Bible to be the Word of God? How can we best study it? These questions are characteristic of those asked many times of local church leaders and teachers. *You & Your Bible* will help you to be able to answer them.

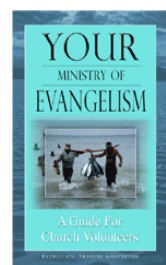
## **Understanding Music and Worship: Brother Darius Wheeler**

## **Your Ministry of Evangelism: Evangelist Deborah Bethel-Patterson**

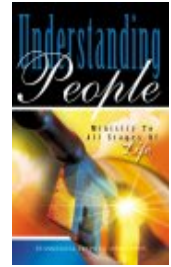

efforts, visitation, discipling new believers, and the importance of prayer in the entire process of evangelism.

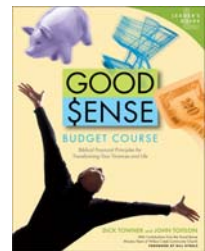
**Understanding People: Deacon Eugene Hollingsworth/Deaconess Sharon Hollingsworth**
